The configuration.php file is unwritable I don't see the file in the public\_html at this point in the install for it to even be writeable.

The register global emulation is set to on instead of off. But no place does the install check tell me how to change this.

mambots/system/ claims to not be writable either I looked at the fill in CPanel File Manager and it shows that it is writeable 777

I must be doing something wrong

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Hi there!

Ok, one of the problems "register global emulation ", this is something that can be changed only in your php.ini file if your host allows it! Better contact them regarding this issue and see if they allow you to change it!

Second, the permissions thing, if you don't see the file configuration.php, try and create it(even empty) with permissions 777 upon it!

The third problem mambots/system/, you will need to re-check that, else i you may continue the install, it will work ok, but when you will try and upload mambots to the site you might get that error again!
