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I have the problem of using a large MySQL DB to a new server, infact I only need to move the DB, the files are already on the new server.

The DB is 180MB in size, this was the statement of my programmer I do not want to hire for this job again and the MySQL File from dumping it via PHP MyAdmin is 16MB in size containing loosely 15,000 products of my VirtueMart shop.

I just run Joomlapack but it seems to be stuck exactly in the VM\_Product Part of the backup and so does not work.

Will there be no problem when using the paid version of this software when wanting to move the DB?

P.S.: What will you charge for a move of the MySQL incl. changing the Access parameters of the new Database in the system only and not for a complete move of the site as the files are already on the new server.

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Hi there! The issues you have could be fixed by running a repair query on your mysql tables. the scripts are not the issue, the database server is closing the connection when reaching that part due to probably some inconsistent data!
